Of all the deceptions carried from ancient Babylon to modern Christendom, perhaps none has endured as powerfully—or as subtly—as the image of the **mother and child**. It graces stained-glass windows, cathedral sculptures, and even pop culture stages. It is revered in church altars and replicated in cultural celebrations. To most, it appears harmless—even holy. But beneath the halo of the Madonna and child lies an ancient counterfeit: **Semiramis and Tammuz**, the pagan original.

This formula—**mother exalted, child eclipsed**—is precisely what would later resurface in Roman Catholicism. The names were changed, but the spirit remained. Mary replaced Semiramis, Jesus replaced Tammuz, and the Babylonian mother cult was baptized.

II. The Marian Shift: From Humble Servant to Global Queen

In the Gospels, **Mary is humble, obedient, and devout**. She never claims divinity, nor does she seek veneration. When praised, she deflects glory to God: *“My soul doth magnify the Lord”* (Luke 1:46). She disappears almost entirely from Scripture after Acts 1, where she is present—but silent—among the 120 believers.

But centuries later, the Roman Catholic Church slowly began **elevating her status**, not through Scripture but through tradition, mystical visions, and theological drift:

- **431 AD** – Mary declared “Mother of God” at the Council of Ephesus.
- **1854** – The dogma of the **Immaculate Conception** (Mary was sinless).
- **1950** – The dogma of the **Assumption** (Mary bodily ascended to Heaven).
- **Today** – Calls for Mary to be declared **“Co-Redemptrix”** and **“Queen of All Nations.”**

This transformation reflects the exact pattern seen in Babylon:

From human mother → to goddess → to throne-sharing queen.

In art and liturgy, Mary is now depicted as **crowned, robed in light**, and **enthroned beside Christ**. She is invoked as a **mediator**, a **comforter**, a **defender**, and even a **dispenser of grace**—all roles explicitly reserved for Christ alone in Scripture.

- **Fatima (1917)** – Mary gives messages and secrets to children, warning of judgment and calling for the consecration of Russia.
- **Medjugorje (1981–present)** – Mary continues to appear regularly, speaking of peace, prayer, and unity among all religions.

What's common among these appearances?

1. **Global reach and media spectacle.**
2. **Messages of peace, unity, and ecumenism.**
3. **Encouragement to pray the rosary and consecrate oneself to Mary.**
4. **Emphasis on Mary's role in salvation and her desire to unite humanity.**

In nearly every apparition, **Jesus is mentioned only in passing**, if at all. The spotlight is on **Mary as intercessor, prophetess, and queen.**
