Subtitle: Jesus Warned Us About This

—Matthew 24:4–6

The very first warning was **deception**.

Birth Pangs – What Jesus Meant

—Matthew 24:8

The Greek word for "sorrows" is *odin*—literally referring to **labor pains**. This gives us three powerful truths:

And I will turn thee back, and put hooks into thy jaws, and I will bring thee forth, and all thine army...

Persia, Ethiopia, and Libya with them... Gomer, and all his bands; the house of Togarmah of the north quarters, and all his bands...

These names may not mean much at first glance, but when we trace their historical roots, the pieces become alarmingly clear.

Who Are the Nations in Ezekiel 38?

Let's break down these prophetic names and how they map to modern-day nations:

- **Gog:** A title, likely referring to a leader—not a nation.
- **Magog:** Commonly identified with the peoples north of the Black Sea, often interpreted as modern-day **Russia**.
- **Meshech and Tubal:** Ancient cities in what is now **Turkey**, though some scholars link Meshech (Moscow) and Tubal (Tobolsk) to regions in **Russia**.
- **Persia:** No interpretation needed. In 1935, Persia officially became **Iran**.
- **Ethiopia and Libya:** Often interpreted as **Northern African nations**, particularly **Sudan** and **Libya**, both of which are Islamic and hostile to Israel.
- **Gomer and Togarmah:** Associated with modern **Turkey**, especially its eastern regions.

What's shocking is this: **every one of these nations is either allied today or trending toward military cooperation**, and they all share one thing in common—a **growing hostility toward Israel**.

The Rise of Russia and Iran: A Prophetic Power Axis

Russia and Iran are now **military partners, nuclear collaborators, and economic allies**. Iran has provided Russia with **hundreds of military drones**, and Russia is providing Iran with **advanced air defense systems**, satellite intelligence, and energy infrastructure support.

This is no shallow alliance. This is **Magog and Persia walking in lockstep**, with a unified hatred of the Jewish state and the Western world. Neither Russia nor Iran are merely reacting to NATO—they are moving according to a deeper spirit, one foretold in Scripture.

Iran has long vowed to **“wipe Israel off the map.”** Russia has increasingly sided with Israel's enemies at the UN, while conducting joint naval drills with China and Iran in the Gulf of Oman. Togarmah, listed among the attackers in Ezekiel 38, is a region in **eastern Turkey**. Under President Erdoğan, Turkey has shifted from a moderate, Western-leaning nation to a growing Islamic nationalist power.

Erdoğan has openly supported Hamas, denounced Israel's right to Jerusalem, and offered sanctuary to exiled leaders of radical Islamic groups. Turkey is also pursuing drone and missile technology that rivals Iran's ambitions. Once a key NATO partner, it now walks a fine line—**officially in the West but ideologically aligned with the East**.

Ezekiel saw this long before it appeared in any defense agreement.

Revelation 16: The Kings of the East

While Ezekiel focuses on the northern alliance that comes against Israel, **the Book of Revelation introduces another powerful force**—one from the East.

Revelation 16:12 (KJV)

And the sixth angel poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.

This reference to the **Kings of the East** is often interpreted as a massive coalition of Asian powers, potentially led by **China**, joined by **North Korea**, and possibly including **India**, **Pakistan**, or other militarized nations in the region.

China now boasts the largest navy in the world and has been openly preparing for war with Taiwan. It has forged growing ties with Russia, entered joint defense arrangements with Iran, and established military outposts along trade routes once known as the Silk Road.

The **drying of the Euphrates** may symbolize a spiritual or literal removal of restraint, clearing the way for these Eastern powers to march toward Israel in the final battle.

What matters is this: **China's emergence as a global superpower is not merely political—it is prophetically significant.**

Israel: God's Timepiece

All prophecy hinges on **Israel**. No nation is more central to God's plan or more central in the enemy's crosshairs. Jesus Himself said:

And when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies, then know that the desolation thereof is nigh.

— Luke 21:20 (KJV)

Today, Israel is surrounded on all sides by either direct enemies or unstable neighbors. Gaza is a launching pad for terror. Hezbollah controls southern Lebanon. Syria hosts Iranian militias. Turkey and Iran fund and harbor radicals. Russia has military presence in Syria and allies with Israel's foes.

Even so-called Western allies like the United States and Europe are increasingly turning against Israel diplomatically, financially, and socially. Antisemitism is rising, not just in the streets but in the highest halls of power.

This aligns with Zechariah 12:

Behold, I will make Jerusalem a cup of trembling unto all the people round about... And in that day will I make Jerusalem a burdensome stone for all people...

— Zechariah 12:2–3 (KJV)

Israel is already becoming the **burdensome stone**. The whole world is beginning to wrestle with it. And the nations aligning against her are the very ones Ezekiel and Revelation foresaw.

Why These Alliances Matter

Some might say, "So what? Nations ally and break alliances all the time."

- **Moral relativism.**

And the more desperate the world becomes, the more willing it is to **sacrifice anything to avoid conflict**—including truth, justice, and sovereignty.

Isaiah warned about this long ago:

“Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil...”

—Isaiah 5:20

False peace is a mask for spiritual rebellion. And that mask is about to be ripped off.

The Role of the United Nations: False Peacekeepers

Since its founding in 1945, the **United Nations** has positioned itself as the **world's peace broker**. Its mission: prevent wars, mediate conflicts, and promote human rights.

But the UN has increasingly become a vehicle for:
