This is more than poetry. It’s architecture.

In the creation account, **God doesn’t create a spinning globe orbiting a star in an infinite vacuum**. Instead, He builds a **firmament**—a fixed, solid structure—right in the middle of a watery mass. This firmament divides the **waters above** from the **waters below**. Ancient readers understood this as a **dome**—a solid expanse, like beaten metal (Job 37:18), that encapsulates the Earth and holds back the upper waters.

This is not symbolic. The Hebrew word used for “firmament” is “**rāqîa’**”, which literally means something **stretched out, spread thin, or beaten like a sheet of metal**. It is not empty space. It’s a **physical barrier**. This is reiterated in the **Book of Job**, in **Psalms**, and even in **Ezekiel’s visions**. We’ll explore those connections deeper in future essays, but the foundation is laid right here in Genesis.

## **Dividing Waters? What Does That Even Mean?**

This detail is strange to the modern ear. **Waters above the sky?** In the NASA generation, we’re taught that above us is atmosphere, then vacuum. But Genesis claims something else: a cosmic sea above our heads—held in place by a firmament.

*“And the likeness of the firmament upon the heads of the living creature was as the colour of the terrible crystal, stretched forth over their heads above.”*

Ezekiel's prophetic vision gives us our first concrete descriptor of the ceiling of heaven: *“the terrible crystal.”* This is not simply poetic language. The Hebrew word used here is **qerach**, meaning “ice,” “frost,” or “crystal.” Ezekiel wasn't merely awestruck by beauty—he was stunned by the awe-inducing solidity and clarity of the structure he saw stretched out above the cherubim. It was a *terrifying* thing, because it was real.

This firmament is not some vaporous mist or empty space. It's solid, bright, reflective, and stretched out like a polished surface—*over their heads above*. Ezekiel's description mirrors the one in Genesis 1, where the firmament divides the waters above from the waters below. He is standing beneath it, looking up. And above it? The throne of God.

This is the structure that separates our visible realm from the heavenly one. You and I are under it. The glory of God is above it.

### **Job 37:18 – The Molten Looking Glass**

*“Hast thou with him spread out the sky, which is strong, and as a molten looking glass?”*

— **Job 37:18**

Here, the “sky” is likened to a **molten looking glass**—a mirror that has been forged by fire, polished until it gleams like metal. The Hebrew word **chazaq** is used for “strong,” indicating physical strength and durability. This isn't poetry for clouds or atmosphere. This is a solid object—molten, shaped, hardened.

Now, ask yourself: how can the sky be “strong”? How can it be “like a mirror”? You don’t need to spiritualize this away. If we take the Bible literally—especially when it’s not presented as a metaphor—we arrive at a different model than the one we’re taught in school. We find a sky that’s not endless but *contained*. John’s apocalyptic vision aligns with Ezekiel’s. In fact, it amplifies it. Now the firmament is not only described as *terrible crystal* or *molten glass*, but as a *sea of glass*. This sea lies **before the throne** of God—just like Ezekiel said. It’s the very foundation of heaven’s floor. And if heaven is above the firmament (as Genesis 1 also declares), then this “sea of glass” is what caps the dome above our realm.

Some try to argue that this “sea” is symbolic of God’s majesty or calmness. But John is using descriptive, spatial language. He says what he saw *looked like crystal*, it had mass, transparency, and form. It was *a surface*. It wasn’t a poetic suggestion. It was part of a real, structured throne room.

This sea of glass forms the upper limit of our created domain. The Word of God says so.

### **What Is “Raqia”?**

To fully understand the ceiling of heaven, we must revisit the Hebrew word **raqia**, used repeatedly in Genesis 1 and by the prophets. Raqia is often translated as “firmament,” but its root meaning is “to beat or spread out thin,” like a sheet of metal. Think of a blacksmith hammering out a large piece of metal into a dome. Even ancient Jewish scholars believed the raqia was a firm, dome-like object. The Septuagint translated it as **stereoma**, which means “a solid structure.” Early Christian writers agreed.

In Genesis 7:11, a haunting phrase is etched into the biblical timeline: “*the windows of heaven were opened.*” This wasn’t poetic hyperbole or a romantic metaphor—it was a literal cataclysm. The fountains of the deep were broken up, and the floodgates of heaven, above the firmament, were violently flung open. A judgment of unimaginable force poured down upon the Earth.

But what exactly opened? Where were these “windows”? And why does the Bible later refer to these same waters again—*not* as gone, but preserved for a future day of reckoning?

*“And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters.”*

*(Genesis 1:6)*

Above this firmament were waters—literal waters, not clouds, not vapor. Waters. That’s what makes the flood’s origin so shocking. The deluge came not just from underground (“fountains of the great deep”), but from *above*—through openings in this dome.

The idea of a celestial barrier—holding back primal waters—is found across ancient cultures, but the Bible reveals it not as myth but as mechanism. The firmament is the ceiling of our reality. And when God opens it, judgment follows.

## **II. Genesis 7:11 – The Windows of Heaven Were Opened**

*“In the six hundredth year of Noah’s life, in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month... were all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened.”*

*(Genesis 7:11)*

Notice the dual source: from below and above. The earth was assaulted on two fronts. This language doesn’t suggest gentle rainfall—it describes supernatural rupture.

The phrase “*windows of heaven*” is used elsewhere in the Old Testament to describe sudden downpours of divine judgment—or blessing (see Malachi 3:10). These are literal openings in the firmament dome. Not a poetic description of rain clouds, but apertures that allow the waters above to descend into our realm.

Ancient Hebrew cosmology, consistent with the Bible, portrays the earth as enclosed: waters above, the firmament separating them, and God enthroned above it (Psalm 148:4, Ezekiel 1:22). The Flood confirms this architecture. The dome wasn’t metaphorical. It was functional.

And God used it.

## **III. Waters Above—Still There**

One of the most important—and ignored—truths in Scripture is that the waters above didn’t go away after the flood.

If Genesis 1:7 says the firmament divided the waters, and Genesis 7:11 says they were poured down, the logical question becomes: were they all emptied?

The answer is no.

The Bible never says the firmament was destroyed. In fact, it remains the very ceiling beneath God's throne. In Job 37:18, it is described as a "*looking glass*," and in Ezekiel 1, a "*terrible crystal*" above the heads of the cherubim.

Psalms 148:4 calls out to the waters *still* above the heavens:

*"Praise him, ye heavens of heavens, and ye waters that be above the heavens."*

This is *post-flood language*, indicating those waters are still present. God *used* the waters of judgment—but He did not exhaust them.

Why does that matter?

Because Scripture tells us that those waters are reserved again for a final judgment.

#### **IV. 2 Peter 3 – The Waters of Judgment Will Return**

The apostle Peter, in his second epistle, draws a chilling connection between the flood of Noah's day and a future reckoning:

*"Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished: But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment."*

*(2 Peter 3:6–7)*

Here, Peter confirms the Earth *was* destroyed by water. But then he says something more: the *same word* that unleashed those waters has *reserved* the heavens and earth again—this time for fire.

Notice the phrase "*kept in store*". The world is not evolving into a better version of itself. It's being held in place—on pause—awaiting judgment.

And what does Peter mention earlier in the chapter?

*"...There shall come in the last days scoffers... saying, Where is the promise of his coming?"*

*(2 Peter 3:3–4)*

They deny the flood. They deny the dome. They deny that there was ever a watery judgment, and so they will be unprepared when fire rains down from the heavens.

The waters above were the first purge. The fire from above will be the last.

### **V. Malachi 3:10 – When Heaven’s Windows Bring Blessing**

Interestingly, the Bible does not always use “windows of heaven” negatively. In Malachi 3:10, God uses the same phrase in a very different context:

*“...prove me now herewith... if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing...”*

Same windows. Different contents. The firmament’s openings can bring rain, wrath, or reward. God controls the tap. This proves they’re not just atmospheric metaphors—they’re literal gates in a real structure.

Blessing, famine (2 Kings 7:2), and deluge—each originate from this mechanism. God holds the key. And His timing is perfect.

### **VI. Scientific Pushback and the Suppression of Structure**

Modern science scoffs at the firmament. It relegates Genesis 1 to poetic folklore and insists that space is an infinite vacuum with no ceiling.

But ancient cultures—from the Hebrews to the Babylonians, Egyptians, and even early Christian commentators—believed in a domed Earth with water above.

So what changed?

The Enlightenment and Freemasonry both played a role in divorcing cosmology from theology. The Copernican revolution and later evolutionism unseated the Bible’s geocentric, domed model in favor of an atheistic, ever-expanding universe.

In Revelation 6:14:

NASA's rocket logos often include serpentine tongues and chevron symbols that resemble piercing the dome. Their own documents reference "upper atmospheric layers" and "firm structures."
