The Scroll & the Seven Thunders – Series Introduction

Why this series exists

Revelation 10 records one of the most arresting moments in Scripture: John hears **seven thunders** speak, raises his pen to record their words, and is stopped by a voice from heaven—“*Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not.*” (Rev. 10:4, KJV). God reveals that there is more to the story...and then withholds it.

This series examines that holy hush.

Our working thesis is simple and provocative: the **seventh** thunder is already unsealed—**the Book of Revelation itself**, the final, public judgment. The **first six** thunders, however, were **concealed resets** in the Church Age—earth-shaking interventions that rhyme with Revelation’s judgments but were **hidden** to prevent confusion, premature date-setting, and doctrinal shipwreck. Those sealed thunders explain why history groans with traces of cataclysm, melted stone, orphaned architecture, erased records, and rewritten timelines—yet the great and terrible Day still lies ahead.

This is **strong meat** (Heb. 5:14). We are not playing with hobby horses; we are training discernment for an hour thick with deception.

Scriptural frame for “sealed yet true”

- **Revelation 10:1–4** — Thunders speak; John is forbidden to write.
- **Daniel 12:4, 9** — Words **sealed** until the time of the end.
- **2 Corinthians 12:4** — Paul hears “unspeakable words... **not lawful** to utter.”
- **Proverbs 25:2** — God is glorified to **conceal** a matter; kings are honored to **search** it out.
- **Amos 3:7** — The Lord reveals His secret to His servants the prophets.
- **2 Thessalonians 2:7–12** — The **mystery of iniquity** and **strong delusion** operative in history.

Together these passages establish a biblical category for **true revelation that is intentionally withheld or time-locked**, and they justify a careful, Scripture-first exploration of history’s anomalies through that lens.

What we mean by “reset”

A *reset* is a God-allowed (and at times God-initiated) intervention that **restructures** human affairs: populations, borders, power, memory, and technology. Noah’s Flood, Babel’s confusion, Sodom’s fire, Egypt’s plagues, the Babylonian exile, and A.D. 70 are canonical examples. Our contention is that comparable **post-resurrection** resets occurred—sealed as the **first six thunders**—so that believers would not mistake them for the **seventh**.

Why would God conceal six and reveal the seventh?

Three pastoral reasons:

1. **Protection of the gospel’s simplicity.** Early believers scarcely had the canon in hand; publishing six Revelation-like calamities could have drowned the Church in misreads (2 Cor. 11:3).
2. **Precision of prophetic timing.** Concealment preserves the distinction between **rehearsals** and the **final act**, so the remnant doesn’t call every storm Armageddon (Matt. 24:6).
3. **Mercy in the midst of judgment.** God restrains disclosure so that His people will **watch** and **work**, not spiral into paralyzing speculation (Luke 19:13; 1 Thes. 5:6).

By contrast, the **seventh thunder** is **declared**, because it is **the** open court of heaven—trumpets, vials, beast system, visible return of the King—**unmistakable** when it arrives.

Method: how we will handle strong claims without losing our minds

We are **KJV-anchored**, Christ-exalting, and unafraid to test patterns. Our approach:

1. **Establish biblical categories** (sealed speech, resets, concealed timing).
2. **Observe historical fingerprints** that consistently recur: melted stone, half-buried doors, sudden city-wide “fires,” orphan trains, erased timelines, lost technologies, occult statecraft, surveillance grids.
3. **Refuse date-setting** and **reject dogmatism** where Scripture is silent (Deut. 29:29). We will **propose, compare, and test** (1 Thes. 5:21).
4. **Keep the telos in view:** the point is not secret knowledge, but **sober readiness**, holiness, and hope (Tit. 2:13; 1 John 3:3).

Key terms (as we use them)

- **Sealed thunder** — A divinely permitted reset in the Church Age whose details were withheld from the biblical record (Rev. 10:4).
- **Antiquitech** — Old-world infrastructure and design that appear to harvest resonance/energy (towers, domes, spires) and were later repurposed or suppressed.
- **Mud-flood** — Fast burial events evidenced by sub-grade windows, sunk doors, and “first floors” under current streets.
- **Industrial mirage** — The selective “rediscovery” and monopolization of tech framed as invention to shift societies into debt-energy slavery.
- **Digital dominion** — The surveillance matrix (AI, biometrics, algorithmic herding) that conditions the world for Rev. 13 compliance.

No. The **categories** (sealed speech, resets, concealed timing) are biblical. Our historical **applications** are inferential and held with humility, always subordinate to Scripture.

“Why talk about resets at all?”

Because ignoring providential patterns breeds preterist confusion on one side and panicked sensationalism on the other. Seeing rehearsals for what they are helps the Church avoid **false alarms** and prepare for the **final siren**.

“Couldn’t this encourage conspiracy thinking?”

It could—if untethered from the Word and the fear of the Lord. Our goal is not to idolize secret knowledge but to **brace the remnant** with biblical discernment, repentance, and hope.

How to read this series (pastoral counsel)

- **Bring your Bible open** (KJV) and your heart soft. Strong claims require stronger humility.
- **Mark the distinctions:** rehearsals vs. finale; sealed hints vs. revealed doctrine.
- **Watch your spirit:** curiosity without obedience produces pride; discernment with holiness produces **steadfastness**.
- **Refuse fear.** The point of prophetic study is **comfort** and **courage** (1 Thes. 4:18; 5:11).

What it means for the remnant now

1. **Hold the line on the gospel.** Resets come and go; **Christ crucified, risen, and returning** does not.
2. **Practice non-compliance with lies.** Whether architectural, historical, medical, or digital—**love the truth** (2 Thes. 2:10).
3. **Build ark-like lives.** Local church, Scripture saturation, prayer, family order, practical preparedness, generosity to the saints.

4. **Expect clarity, not confusion, at the end.** The **seventh thunder** will be unmistakable—global, cosmic, Christ-centered. When He comes, no one will need a thread to explain it (Matt. 24:27, 30).

The controlling confession

“The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.” (Rev. 11:15)

We are not chasing shadows to feel clever; we are tracing **providence** to stand faithful. The six thunders—if our reading is right—were the Father’s wise concealments across the Church Age. The seventh is His **open verdict**. These studies are offered to sharpen the remnant, steady the fearful, and keep our eyes on **the Blessed Hope**.

The scroll is open. The final thunder will speak.

Until then—**watch, work, and keep your lamp burning.**

1 of 10: The Scroll and the Seven Thunders – Thunder Sealed: The Mystery of the Unspoken Voice

“And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, *Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not.*” — Revelation 10:4 (KJV)

Introduction: The Sound John Heard But We Did Not

The book of Revelation is many things—a vision, a prophecy, a cosmic drama, and a war scroll from heaven. It is a manual for the remnant, a weapon for the discerning, and a mirror for the world that refuses to see. Yet buried deep in this already enigmatic book is a moment of *intentional divine silence*. A moment that arrests the narrative. A voice like thunder—seven in total—utters something so potent, so explosive, so contextually critical that John, the apostle seer of Patmos, lifts his pen to record it...

And is stopped.

“Write it not.”

No explanation. No elaboration. Only silence.

And in that silence—the thunder of mystery still echoes.

This essay opens our ten-part journey into the Scroll and the Seven Thunders. Here, we examine the strange episode in Revelation 10 where seven thunders speak, and heaven forbids their transcription. Why would God seal these thunders? What role do they play in the eschatological unfolding of history? Could they be hidden resets or judgments? And how does their concealment protect the Church Age from deception and distortion?

This isn't just prophetic curiosity. It's a key to interpreting the present world—with its forgotten ruins, false timelines, and post-Flood architecture—as part of a war in the heavens that bleeds through time.

Section I: The Scroll in the Hand of the Mighty Angel

Revelation 10 opens with one of the most majestic beings ever described in the biblical record:

“And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of fire:” (Revelation 10:1)

This is not just any angel. His description rivals the Lord Jesus Christ Himself in Revelation 1:13–15. Many believe this mighty angel **is Christ**, or at the very least, carries His authority. He comes **with a little book open** in His hand—a scroll already unsealed.

That scroll is key.

This “little book” is not the same seven-sealed book from Revelation 5 (the title deed to Earth). This one is already opened, and it appears between trumpet six and trumpet seven—as if to say *there is something else you need to understand before the final trumpet sounds*. A hidden interlude.

In His presence, the angel plants one foot on the sea and one on the earth—establishing **cosmic dominion**. He then cries with a loud voice, as when a lion roars (v. 3). And then:

“Seven thunders utter their voices.”

What are these thunders? The Greek for “uttered” implies articulate speech, not just noise. These thunders speak **intelligible information**—John understood it, and was ready to write it down.

But a divine voice stops him.

Section II: The Strange Command – “Seal It Up”

The phrase “seal up” in verse 4 is deliberate and rare. In the Bible, sealing can mean two things: **to preserve for a future time** or **to withhold from understanding**. In this case, it is both.

Consider:

- In **Daniel 12:4**, Daniel is told to “shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end.”
- In **2 Corinthians 12:4**, Paul hears “unspeakable words, which it is not lawful for a man to utter.”
- In **Proverbs 25:2**, “It is the glory of God to conceal a thing: but the honour of kings is to search out a matter.”

This is not the first time Heaven has chosen **to withhold revelation** from even the most faithful servants. But why?

The answer may lie in the nature of what was said.

The seven thunders—likely echoing the voice of God Himself (see Psalm 29, where “the voice of the Lord” is described as thunder seven times)—spoke truths so profound, so disruptive, or so potentially misunderstood, that God in His wisdom **withheld them from the prophetic timeline**. And yet... the sound was recorded. Their existence was revealed.

Which means: **they matter**.

We just weren’t ready.

Section III: A Theory of Divinely Hidden Resets

Here is where we introduce the central thesis of this 10-part series:

The Seven Thunders represent divine judgments and cataclysms—six of which have already occurred since the time of Christ but were sealed to avoid confusing the Church. The seventh thunder is the Tribulation judgment revealed in Revelation itself.

These are not symbolic. These are not vague. These are literal, historical resets—**the kind of earth-altering, timeline-shattering events** that leave behind melted cities, buried technology, inexplicable architecture, and rewritten history.

Why keep them hidden?

Because each reset mimics, to some degree, the judgments described in Revelation. If revealed prematurely, they could confuse the Body of Christ, especially in the early centuries when believers lacked the full canon of Scripture and prophetic discernment. By sealing the thunders, God protected the simplicity of the gospel from being overwhelmed by catastrophism.

"But I fear, lest by any means... your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ." — 2 Corinthians 11:3

Yet now, in these **last days**, the echo of those thunders is being unsealed—not in full words, but in **evidence**, in **architecture**, in **ancient ruins and desert bones**, and in the **prophetic stirrings** of those watching for the return of Christ.

Section IV: Scriptural Echoes of Thunder

To grasp the gravity of these thunders, we must explore where Scripture uses thunder as a **metaphor for the divine voice** and **global shaking**.

- **Psalm 18:13:** "The Lord also thundered in the heavens... yea, he sent out his arrows, and scattered them."
- **Job 37:5:** "God thundereth marvellously with his voice; great things doeth he."
- **John 12:29:** When God speaks from heaven, some say it "thundered."
- **Exodus 19:16:** When God descends on Mount Sinai, the people hear "thunders and lightnings."

In every case, thunder is associated with **judgment, presence, revelation, and awe**.

But thunder also **precedes something greater**. It is a warning shot—a precursor to action.

So when seven thunders speak in Revelation 10, it's not random noise. It's not background ambiance.

It's **divine intelligence**.

Suppressed.

Concealed.

Delayed—for now.

Section V: Why John Was About to Write

John was no novice to heavenly sounds. He had already written visions of beasts, trumpets, dragons, and stars falling like figs. Why was this the moment he reached for his pen?

Because **he understood the words**.

These thunders weren't vague. They were crystal clear to the apostle. His intention to write tells us they contained information **meant to be read, recorded, or remembered**—had God not intervened.

That tells us three things:

1. **The thunders contain logical content**—not emotional overload.
2. **The thunders fit the pattern of prophecy**—John thought they belonged.
3. **The thunders were halted by Heaven itself**—because timing matters to God.

And so, the pen paused. And the thunder, for a moment, fell silent.

But history? It kept shaking.

Section VI: The Spiritual and Prophetic Implications of Silence

It's often said, "*When God is silent, He's still speaking.*" The sealed thunders are **not void**—they are **volcanic potential**, held back by grace.

Each one—if unsealed—would unleash a storm of interpretation, fear, doctrine, and distraction. The early church could barely defend the Trinity, justification by faith, and the deity of Christ—how would it have handled advanced resets, mud floods, and lost civilizations?

God's silence was not neglect.

It was strategy.

Because the sealed scroll wasn't the end—it was the pause before the final thunder: the **seventh thunder**—the one we *are* allowed to see. And this one isn't sealed.

It's the Book of Revelation itself.

Section VII: The Seventh Thunder Unsealed – The Great Tribulation

Let's be clear: Revelation **is** the seventh thunder.

It is the **final judgment**, the ultimate reset, the unveiling of Jesus Christ as King of Kings and Lord of Lords. Every plague, vial, trumpet, and beast is part of the final thunder echoing through time—and it is *not* sealed.

But to distinguish it from the six prior resets, the Church must learn to **see the difference**:

- The seven-year tribulation is globally coordinated.
- It involves supernatural players: Antichrist, False Prophet, and the Beast System.
- It culminates in **the return of Christ in glory**, not a geopolitical reshuffle.

This is why the first six had to be sealed—**so that the true seventh could be unmistakable** when it arrives.

Section VIII: The Book Eaten – A Bittersweet Calling

In Revelation 10:9–10, John is told to eat the book in the angel's hand:

“Take it, and eat it up; and it shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall be in thy mouth sweet as honey.”

This is prophecy's paradox.

It's sweet to know God speaks.

It's bitter to know what He says.

Prophets eat what others ignore. They digest thunder. They carry weight others won't touch.

That's what this series is about. Thunder is sweet to the discerning—and bitter to the world. The hidden resets, the forbidden technologies, the ancient cities buried under lakes and deserts—these aren't fantasy. They're fragments of past judgments—concealed from view, but not from those with eyes to see.

Section IX: What This Means for the Church

If your theory is right (and it resonates strongly with Scripture, history, and even observable archaeology), then this timeline looks like this:

- **Thunder 1–6:** Past, hidden resets allowed by God for judgment, cleansing, or redirection.

- **Thunder 7:** Revelation’s judgment, unsealed, global, and final.

The Church is now standing on the cusp between thunder 6 and 7.

This is the space of prophetic discernment.

This is where we must “rightly divide” (2 Tim. 2:15), lest we confuse past resets for the final judgment and fall into preterist errors, or worse—sleep through the final trumpet thinking it already sounded.

Conclusion: When Thunder Speaks, the Wise Listen

The mystery of the seven thunders isn’t just a gap in Revelation—it’s a **divine margin**, a sacred pause, a hidden rhythm in history.

God knew the dangers of disclosure. He also knew the hunger for revelation.

That’s why He told John: *Don’t write it—but eat it.*

Don’t publish it—*prophesy it when the time is right.*

Don’t announce it—*live it, until the scrolls of thunder unroll like lightning in the skies.*

In this series, we will attempt to trace the fingerprints of each thunder—through Rome, Tartaria, pandemics, fires, wars, and awakenings. Each essay will walk the path of hidden judgment, asking:

Was this a thunder?

And always remembering:

The final one... we already hold in our hands.

The Book is open.

Let’s read what Heaven chose to reveal—while listening carefully... for what it didn’t.

2 of 10: The Scroll and the Seven Thunders – Patterns of Concealment: When God Doesn’t Speak

“It is the glory of God to conceal a thing: but the honour of kings is to search out a matter.” — Proverbs 25:2 (KJV)

Introduction: The Divine Silence That Speaks Louder Than Thunder

We often think of God as a God who speaks. From “Let there be light” in Genesis to “Surely I come quickly” in Revelation, the Word of God is living, active, and powerful. But Scripture also reveals something more unsettling, more mysterious: **sometimes God chooses not to speak**. Sometimes, at the moment when revelation seems most needed, **He withholds. He seals. He conceals.**

And in those moments—He is not being cruel.

He is being precise.

He is being merciful.

He is being God.

In the previous essay, we explored the mysterious moment in Revelation 10 when John hears seven thunders utter their voices and is about to write—but a heavenly voice stops him. “*Write them not.*” In that divine command, we are introduced to the concept of prophetic restraint. Not everything God knows—or even shows—is meant to be revealed. At least not yet.

This second essay digs deeper into **the biblical pattern of concealment**. We will explore other key moments where God sealed knowledge, restrained prophets, or left the curtain closed. From Daniel’s sealed scroll to Paul’s heavenly encounter, from Christ’s words about the timing of His return to the cryptic parables only understood by the initiated—**divine silence emerges as a deliberate strategy** in the outworking of prophecy and time.

And as we’ll see, this strategy directly reinforces the theory that the **seven thunders represent six concealed resets in post-Christ history**, hidden to protect the Church from confusion—and to ensure the seventh thunder (the final judgment) could be clearly discerned when it arrives.

Let us now enter the vaults of divine restraint—and hear what God did *not* say.

Section I: Concealment Is a Pattern, Not an Exception

God concealing truth is not some rare theological curiosity. It is, as Proverbs 25:2 tells us, **part of His glory**. The same God who reveals Himself in burning bushes and parted seas also hides Himself in clouds and thunder.

Theologians call this the **doctrine of progressive revelation**—the idea that God reveals truth in stages, not all at once. But beyond that is something deeper: **strategic silence**.

From the Garden of Eden to the gates of Revelation, God operates in a tension between **concealment and disclosure, mystery and manifestation.**

This is not because He is indecisive or cryptic for the sake of being cryptic. Rather, it is because:

- Timing matters in prophecy.
- Readiness matters in interpretation.
- Discernment matters in application.

In short: **if God spoke everything at once, man would misread everything at once.**

This sets the stage for examining three core moments in Scripture where God intentionally withholds, seals, or silences revelation.

Section II: Daniel's Sealed Prophecies – Truth With a Time Lock

Let's begin with the prophet Daniel. In Daniel 12, after a sweeping apocalyptic vision, he is told:

“But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end...” — Daniel 12:4

Here, Daniel is not just receiving prophecy—he's being *cut off* from sharing all of it. The vision he saw was *true, inspired, and revealed*—yet was deliberately sealed.

And again in verse 9:

“Go thy way, Daniel: for the words are closed up and sealed till the time of the end.”

Why?

Because premature knowledge **would confuse**, not clarify. The vision was too vast, too terrifying, and too forward-looking for Daniel's generation. Even Daniel says, in verse 8, “I heard, but I understood not.”

This isn't a prophet lacking intelligence—it's a prophet restrained by heaven.

God's message: *Not yet.*

What was hidden from Daniel would later be partially unveiled to John on Patmos—but even then, as we saw in Revelation 10, some of that prophecy was *again* sealed (the seven

thunders). Thus, we have a *chain of concealed messages*, withheld until the final moments when they must be understood.

Section III: Paul's Unspeakable Encounter – Words Not Lawful to Utter

Now we turn to Paul, the apostle of mystery and doctrine. In 2 Corinthians 12:2–4, Paul writes:

“I knew a man in Christ... caught up to the third heaven... caught up into paradise, and heard unspeakable words, **which it is not lawful for a man to utter.**”

This is no ordinary vision. Paul enters paradise, the dimension of God's direct presence. He hears *something*. But whatever he heard, **he is forbidden to repeat.**

Let that sink in: a New Testament apostle, entrusted with mysteries of the Church, grace, and Christ's body—**is told to remain silent** about certain divine revelations.

Why?

Because **not all revelations are meant for transmission**. Some are for insulation—spiritual insulation that protects the Church from counterfeit revelations or unnecessary speculation.

Paul, like John, experienced revelation that was sweet—but bitter to the belly. And like Daniel, he was told *not yet*.

Section IV: Jesus and the Withheld Knowledge of His Return

Perhaps the most shocking example of divine restraint is found in Christ's own words:

“But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, **but my Father only.**” — Matthew 24:36

This moment introduces a deliberate limitation. Even the Son, in His earthly ministry, **submits to the Father's concealment** regarding the precise hour of His return.

Now, we can argue over the implications of this theologically, but the **pattern remains**: there is a time to know—and a time to not.

Jesus also spoke in **parables**—veiling truth from the crowds, while explaining privately to His disciples (Matthew 13:10–11). In doing so, He fulfilled Isaiah's prophecy: “hearing ye shall hear, and shall not understand...”

Why would Jesus veil truth?

Because truth **must be desired**. It must be sought. And until the heart is ready, revelation is a liability—not a gift.

Section V: John Again – Revelation 10 as Continuation of Concealment

Returning to Revelation 10, we see John stepping into this tradition of restraint. He receives information from the seven thunders, and is told *not to write*.

This is not just a stylistic cliffhanger—it is part of the prophetic protocol.

God is building a **library of sealed knowledge**, reserved for the discerning in the last days. This knowledge is not withheld out of pettiness, but out of **divine timing**. Imagine if the full content of the seven thunders had been made known in the year 250 A.D. Or even 1054 A.D. What chaos might have ensued?

False alarms. Confused believers. Chronological heresies.

Enter: Preterism, Amillennialism, Kingdom Now Theology.

All theories that confuse timing and judgment—because of incomplete understanding.

But God, in mercy, stopped John from adding to the confusion.

Section VI: The Mercy of Divine Silence

Let us not miss this: God's silence is often His **mercy**.

- He hid the thunder so the Church wouldn't panic at every cataclysm.
- He sealed Daniel's scroll so Israel wouldn't worship the Antichrist too early.
- He silenced Paul's paradise words so mysticism wouldn't replace the gospel.
- He delayed Christ's return hour so we'd live in constant readiness, not date-setting.
- He masked the thunder so we wouldn't **confuse past resets** for the final judgment.

This is not neglect. It is **precision**.

A God who is in full control does not need to say everything at once. He releases revelation like a surgeon releases medicine—**only when the patient is ready**.

If this theory of **six hidden resets since Christ** is true, then God's silence guarded the simplicity of the gospel across two thousand years. Because had He revealed the resets, they would have been mistaken for:

- The Great Tribulation
- The Day of the Lord
- The rise of the Antichrist
- The final Battle of Armageddon

But those are still to come.

So the thunders were hidden—not because they weren't real—but because they were **too real to reveal** prematurely.

Section VII: Concealed Judgment in History

Let us now look at history with this filter.

There are moments—unexplainable, catastrophic, civilization-altering events—that echo the tone of divine thunder. And yet, they're never clearly linked to Revelation. Why?

Because they were **sealed resets**. Hidden judgments.

And the evidence is scattered across the earth like thunder's fading echo.

- Entire cities buried under deserts and oceans.

The first six rumbled in shadows, shaking empires, erasing archives, redrawing borders, and resetting humanity’s memory. They were God’s concealed rehearsals, sounding faint echoes of the judgments to come—signposts in the fog that only the spiritually alert could discern.

But the seventh thunder is no rehearsal. It is the crescendo of every prophecy, the open courtroom of Heaven, the trumpet blast that will drown out every human lie. When this thunder roars, there will be no scholars debating its timing, no governments controlling the narrative, no skeptics demanding “proof.” The sky will split, the Lamb will appear, and the kingdoms of this world will crumble before the King of kings.

This series was never meant to make us conspiracy collectors or secret-knowledge chasers. Its purpose was to pull back the veil just enough for you to see **that history is not random**—that God has been guiding it with a hidden hand, shaping events with both mercy and precision. Each sealed thunder shows us that the Lord can overturn the world in a moment, and yet, for two thousand years, He has restrained Himself for the sake of the gospel. That restraint will not last forever.

We live now in the thin space between the final sealed thunder and the unsealed one. The last grains of sand in the hourglass are falling. The world is primed for a single, global, coordinated rebellion against God—the **beast system**—and Revelation tells us exactly where it ends: with the return of the rightful King.

The thunders were sealed for the sake of the Church, but the gospel has never been sealed. The death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ is still the open invitation to escape the wrath to come. Every hidden reset, every buried truth, every engineered deception in

history ultimately serves this one purpose: to draw the remnant out of Babylon and into the arms of the Savior.

If you take nothing else from this series, take this: **when the final thunder speaks, there will be no time to prepare—only time to stand.** Preparation happens now, in repentance, faith, holiness, and steadfast endurance. The sealed thunders show God's sovereignty over history. The seventh thunder will show His sovereignty over eternity.

The scroll is open. The clock is almost out.

When the last thunder rolls—whose side will you be on?
